The user (students or teachers) can do this and switch back and forth between contrasts – if you are a school, your computer department generally does not need to make these changes.

1. Go to settings in the lower right corner – the icon can vary by Chromebook so it could be a little person with arms up in the air, a white rectangle or a US icon. It will bring up a menu of items.
2. The menu can vary depending on what changes your computer department has allowed students/teachers to make.
3. Scroll down to “accessibility” and click on it
4. Scroll down and click on “High contrast mode”

Note that some things may look very different as light and dark switch places so a picture may look very strange while font and text may look great and very bright. Thus, you will need to teach students how to go back on forth on these settings.
